PRIVACY POLICY

Bankstown Golf Club is subject to the provisions of the Privacy Act 1988. The Act contains 10 National Privacy Principles that set standards for the handling of personal information. Bankstown Golf Club has a commitment to privacy and the safeguarding of members, visitors and staff personal information.

Any personal information provided by you to Bankstown Golf Club (ie name, address, date of birth and contact details), including information collected as a result of a membership card being placed in a gaming machine or other club machine, that is linked to a member loyalty system (not ATM's) that may provide a benefit or service to you, will be protected.

Bankstown Golf Club does not usually disclose your personal information to any other organization or person unless there is a legal requirement to do so. Bankstown Golf Club may also disclose personal information to relevant authorities if it reasonably believes that there is a threat to an individual's life, health or safety, or public health or safety. If Bankstown Golf Club has reason to suspect that unlawful activity has been, is being or may be engaged in, personal information may be used or disclosed as a necessary part of any investigation and reporting to relevant persons or authorities, Bankstown Golf Club may disclose your information to third parties that may provide services under contract to Bankstown Golf Club. These contracts require the third party to keep your personal information confidential and secure.

Your personal information, including information about you obtained as a result of you placing your membership card in a gaming machine or other club machine (not ATM'S), may be used by Bankstown Golf for marketing purposes to improve our services to you with the latest information about those services, any new related services and promotions.

If you do not wish to receive information about services and promotions, Bankstown Golf Club, on request, will remove your name from our mailing lists.

You have a right to access any personal information that the Bankstown Golf Club may hold about you, including a right correction of your information. Bankstown Golf Club will generally not charge a fee for you to access your personal information.

GUIDELINES

The following information is provided for all members so that the enjoyment of the Club's fine facilities will not be impaired by lack of knowledge of the rules and regulations set out in the By-Laws and Constitution of the Club.

PLAYING RIGHTS

- In the absence of special rules, two ball matches have precedence over and are entitled to pass any three or four ball match.
- A single player has no standing and should give way to a match of any kind.
- Any match playing a whole round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round.
- On Club competition days, competitors have the right of the course.

COURTESY ON THE COURSE

In the interest of all, players must play without delay. It is the duty of the player with the lowest handicap to maintain the position of their match in the field and should the match fail to keep up with the group ahead, it is that player's duty to call following players through at the appropriate time. Subject to reasonable standards of safety, players should keep one shot behind the group ahead.

CARE OF THE COURSE

Players must **smooth** out the sand in bunkers on completion of play from the bunker by use of the rakes provided. The rake should be replaced in the direction of the fairway, outside the bunker and **you should leave the bunker as you would like to find it**. Players are asked to repair at least two ball marks on every green.

NON COMPETITION GOLF

All matches shall have equal standing with other matches subject to the listed competition days for all categories and on Tuesdays and Fridays, not being Public Holidays, subject to times reserved for Trade Days, Association events and course maintenance.





PRACTICE ON THE COURSE

Members are advised that playing to, and putting on, any green and playing practice shots from any fairway or bunker on the course are not permitted without approval from the Captain or Match and Play Committee. Members playing a practice round on the course are permitted to play **two balls** only during the play of any one hole.

Players practising on the course are reminded that competitors have the right of the course. At no time should a player “cut in” on any hole when players are on the previous green.

GOLFING VISITORS

Subject to circumstances referred to in the By Laws a member shall not introduce more than three playing visitors on any one occasion and the member must play in the same group as the visitors. Until all competitors have passed through the 1st tee, members may not bring visitors to play on the course on competition days (other than on Invitation days), except with the permission of the Captain.

Children of Members may play on the course at times when visitors are normally permitted, but only when accompanied by a member. Practice must be confined to the defined practice areas. Each player must have a set of Golf Clubs.

COMPLAINTS

All complaints about club employees or other matters shall be made in writing to the General Manager who shall submit them to the committee.

FEE RENEWALS

Fees have been set to assist the club in planning future course and clubhouse development. Full payment is required under the Registered Clubs Act by no later than 31st October each year.

Please note: No grace period is given for late fees. If your fees have not been paid by this date you will become an unfinancial member with no playing or access rights to the club.

In recent times the Board has extended to members the opportunity to pay membership fees by quarterly or monthly instalments.



It should be noted -

1. **The terms of the Registered Clubs' Act provide that all members are liable for fees for the full 12 months of a financial year.**
2. In extending the privilege to pay fees by instalments the Board does so under the following conditions -
 - b) If a member elects to pay fees by instalments the first payment must be made on or before 1st November. Process is by **“Direct Debit” only.**
 - c) In any case where an instalment is not made by the due date all playing rights will be withdrawn until payment is made.

Quarterly and monthly payments include a one off administration charge.

Note:

No quarterly or monthly fees will be applicable to House members, Absentee members and Junior Absentee members.

Under the Registered Clubs Act, trophy vouchers will not be accepted for payment of annual subscriptions, however Bank Card/Master Card/Visa Card facilities are available.

RESIGNATIONS

A member may, by giving notice in writing to the General Manager, resign from membership of the Club. All such resignations shall take effect from the date on which it is received by the General Manager. **Such persons resigning shall remain liable for any annual subscription and all arrears thereof due and unpaid at the date of cessation of membership together with any moneys due.**

DRESS RULES

Members, Lady Members and their guests are expected to maintain their dress and appearance at all times in a manner in keeping with the standards of the club.

The following guidelines have been prepared, but must be regarded as the minimum acceptable standard. The General Manager or his delegate may object to any particular dress, which in their opinion does not meet the standards of the club.

In addition any member of the Board may object to the dress of a member.



Similarly any member of the Ladies Committee may object to the dress of a Lady member.

Metal spikes are not permitted on the course or in the clubhouse. Members visiting other courses are advised to check dress rules prior to attending.

MALES

GOLF COURSE DRESS REGULATIONS.

Shirts must have attached collars and unless specially tailored, must be worn inside trousers or shorts at all times.

Shirts must not display any large advertising logos.

Only tailored shorts or slacks may be worn. Abbreviated or beach style shorts or slacks with tie cord and without a zipper are not permitted.

Denim is NOT ALLOWED.

Long socks may be worn with tailored shorts. Short socks must be predominantly white. All socks must be worn at the full length.

No anklet socks.

Suitable golf shoes must be worn on the course.

The wearing of thongs, sandals or similar footwear on the course or in the clubhouse, is prohibited. Leather boat shoes without socks may be worn in the clubhouse.

FEMALES

Golf shirts must be worn inside shorts, skirts or pants at all times unless tailored.

Mini shorts, mini skirts, stirrup or ski pants, and surf wear garments are not permitted.

Dress, which is permissible on the course, is acceptable in the clubhouse.

The wearing of sandals or similar footwear in the clubhouse is permitted.

Rubber Thongs are not permitted.



ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME OF GOLF

Members are asked to pay particular attention to the following rules of etiquette, observance of which will add to the pleasure on the course of all concerned. Sometimes these rules are not observed as they should be, owing perhaps to lack of thought, or to the intense concentration by a player upon his own game, to the exclusion of the convenience and enjoyment of others.

1. No one should move, talk, and stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
2. No player should play until the party in front is out of range.
3. In the interest of all, players should play without delay.
4. A player who has incurred a penalty should intimate the fact to his opponent or marker as soon as possible.
5. Players while searching for a ball should allow other matches coming up to pass them; they should signal to the players following them to pass, and having given the signal should not continue their play until those players have passed and are out of range.
6. After having played out of a bunker, a player should rake the bunker appropriately.
7. A player should ensure that any turf cut or displaced by him is replaced and covered with sand at once and pressed down, and that on the putting green any pitch mark made by him is repaired as far as possible. Cards should be marked on tees while other players are hitting.
8. Players should ensure that, when dropping bags or the flagstick on the putting green, no damage is done to the putting surface, and that neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing close to the hole or in taking out or replacing the flagstick. The flagstick should be properly replaced in the hole before the players leave the putting green.





SLOW PLAY

THE PACE OF PLAY HAS BEEN DETERMINED AT A MAXIMUM OF 4 HOURS 20 MINUTES PER EIGHTEEN HOLES.

It is the responsibility of the player with the lowest handicap to maintain the position of their match in the field. Should the match fail to keep up with the group ahead, it is that player's duty to call following players through at the appropriate time. Subject to reasonable standards of safety, players should keep one shot behind the group ahead.

The most important thing is to be **always ready** to hit when it is your turn.

This means:

1. Walking directly to your ball and standing adjacent to it (off the fairway if you're in someone's line of sight).
2. Assessing your shot and selecting your club while you wait and watch shots further away than yours. (It is good etiquette to closely watch where your partner's ball goes, so you can reduce time finding it.)
3. **NOT** marking your card on the green but rather whilst you await your turn on the next tee.
4. Having as few practice swings as possible.
5. Calling players through if you are not in a hurry or if you need time to look thoroughly for a ball (five minutes is allowed before a penalty for lost ball applies).
6. Leaving your buggy past the flag on the green and preferably adjacent to the approach to the next tee.
7. Adopting a "hit-if-ready" philosophy only from the tees - during non-medal and non-championship rounds - also speeds up play.

The Committee will impose penalties for slow play. Refer to By Law 3.





**NOTICE TO MEMBERS
FROM MATCH COMMITTEE**

Any competitor desiring to enter a protest in connection with a Match or Competition shall do so in writing addressed to the General Manager and shall deposit same in the box with cards of play. The General Manager shall, upon receipt of such protest, convene at the earliest possible opportunity a meeting of the Match Committee, which shall consider such protest and whose decision shall be final. Protests must be entered immediately on completion of the Match or Competition.

1. Players must check handicap before commencing play in a competition.
2. How count backs will be decided:
 - (i) The best net score over the last 9 holes; should there be a further tie;
 - (ii) The best net score over the last 6 holes; should there be a further tie, the best net score over the last 3 holes
 - (iii) If there is still a tie, the count-back will then be hole by hole from the 18th hole. If still equal, play-off on date to be decided by Match Committee.
3. All elimination and Knock-Out competition matches must be played at Bankstown Golf Club on or before the weekend set down - failure to do so, player or players will forfeit.
4. All scorecards should be completed and signed before entering the club house unless under exceptional circumstances.
5. Scores entered into the computer as soon as possible after the round is completed.
6. It is the responsibility of the player/member entering the scores to check that the scores have been entered correctly.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

All members and visitors must report to the Pro Shop 15 minutes prior to hitting off for purposes of identification, arranging of appropriate hit-off times, payment of green fees and must be suitably attired.

LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf. These are listed on all score cards and Notice Boards. Penalty for breach of Local Rule, two strokes or in match play loss of hole.

TIME SHEETS

For all other competition events a time sheet will be available 1 week prior to the competition day. Match and Play may issue time sheets earlier for public holiday and major events where appropriate.

Men and Ladies are permitted to book a maximum of only four players on any competition day. Cancellations are to be notified as soon as possible to be fair to all players. Failure to adhere to these requirements may lead to disciplinary action by the Board of Directors.





HANDICAP REDUCTIONS

Members are responsible for the correctness of their own handicap and should keep a personal record of scores submitted for handicap through the year. Golfink handicap at the time of registration into the competition is final.

MAJOR EVENTS

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Only amateur golfers are eligible

Unless otherwise stated, in the event of a tie, the winner will be decided by a three hole playoff (10, 11, 18). If tied after these three holes, sudden death will apply (10, 11, 18).

Play in normal competition events will be from the BLUE TEE MARKERS. All major events to be played from the championship tee position unless stated.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

A, A RESERVE, B, C Grade 72 holes Stroke Play.

NOTE – It will be mandatory for top 8 qualifiers in each grade to play in allotted p.m time slots in the seeded draw for the final round. No exemptions will be permitted.

Members must provide a medical certificate to be permitted to use motorised carts.

SENIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

To be played in conjunction with Club Championships. Gross and Net winners (72 holes)

JUNIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP .

36 Hole Stroke Play

Gross and Net winners

HANDICAP CHAMPIONSHIP

A, A Reserve, B, C Grade Net winners and Runners up. To be played in conjunction with Club Championship.





MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

8 qualifiers per grade (A, A Reserve, B, C) being the leading players from the stroke play championships who can participate in seeded draw on the allotted dates. All rounds and semi-finals will be played over 18 holes. Finals to be played over 36 holes. Only current financial members will be eligible to play in this competition.

FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP. (Saturday – 26th June)

A Grade 36 hole Stroke, B and C Grades 18 hole Stroke Gross and Net winners (day to be played in sixes)

(A Grade players who hit off odd numbered tees in the 1st round must hit off even numbered tees in the 2nd round)

Note: A Grade teams are only eligible to win one prize on the day - highest monetary amount.

MIXED FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP.

(Sunday-14th November)

36 hole Stroke - Gross and Net winners (day to be played in sixes).

Men hit off odd numbered tees in 1st round. Ladies hit off odd numbered tees in the 2nd round. Teams are only eligible to win one prize on the day - highest monetary amount.

BANKSTOWN CUP. (Sunday 31st October)

Open 18 hole Stroke Vardon event

Open 18 hole Stroke Net

AM tee times only

(Handicap limits - Visitors to 6, Members to 12)

In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided by an 18 hole play off at a date to be negotiated.

GALBRAITH MEMORIAL TROPHY -

(Qualifying Saturday 3rd July)

It is a player's responsibility to place a "G" on their card if they wish to qualify for the event.

Singles Handicap Match Play event

18 holes Net

32 to qualify (10 per grade and best two remaining, ties to be decided by count back). All matches played in fours.

Match Play 18 holes handicap. Final 36 holes on a Sunday.

Handicap at time of qualifying to apply throughout.





Times will be allocated for all matches. The higher ranking qualifer receives tee time preference. However, by mutual agreement matches may be played prior to the date. Please advise General Manager or Captain of change.

ECLECTIC COMPETITION

Competitors play two or more rounds and the eclectic score is the lowest obtained at each hole on the rounds.

Handicap to be half that applicable as at 1st eclectic round.

COCK OF THE WALK (only class 1 members eligible)

It is a player's responsibility to place a "C" on their card if they wish to qualify for the event.

Two Ball Handicap Match Play events.

18 holes 2 Ball to qualify Saturday 27th February, Sunday 28th February

16 pairs per Saturday and Sunday to qualify. Ties to be decided by count back.

Members who fail to qualify on Saturday may attempt to qualify on Sunday (with a different partner).

Play offs 18 holes. There will be a Saturday finalist and a Sunday finalist with both finalists playing a Grand Final over 36 holes, on Sunday 3rd May.

Handicap at time of qualifying to apply throughout.

The draw will be released as early as possible (Monday /Tuesday of that week).

BROTHERS CUP. (Saturday- 25th September)

Open 2 Ball Aggregate Stableford 18 holes

One Brother must be a member of BGC.

In the event of a tie - count back

GOLD MEDAL (Saturday- 1st May)

Winners of all medals during the preceding twelve months will play off for the Gold Medal in conjunction with the medal round for May. Competitors shall play off the handicap that prevails on the day of play. In the event of a tie, play off will be held in the next medal round.





MEMBERS CUP

36 Hole net event played in conjunction with the Monthly Medals of February and March. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided by the next Monthly medal.

GRETNA GREEN (Sunday- 7th November)

18 Hole Open 2 Ball event open to men and ladies. Main trophy is net event - restricted to Husbands and Wives. Scratch trophy and individual events in conjunction. In the event of a tie, winners to be decided by count back.

PRESIDENTS CUP (Saturday- 18th September)

Four Ball Ambrose. To be eligible for the Cup there must be at least one member from each Grade in the team.

In the event of a tie, winners to be decided by count back.

Minimum three tee shots from each player to be used.

PRESENTATION OF MEMBERS TROPHIES

Competition cards must be returned immediately round completed.
Winners of events are asked to attend the trophy presentation.
The last group should submit all cards within 15min of the group
in front.





TROPHY ALLOCATION

In the event of competitions not reaching the required numbers the Match and Play committee has the authority to determine trophies presented.

Note- Medal days- winners may only receive one trophy

Note- Visitors/Reciprocal members must receive permission from the General Manager or Club Captain to play on a medal day

Note – Individual winners may win one 2 Ball trophy.

Note – Christmas Hams Days 2 Ball Winners **CANNOT** win an individual trophy.

SWINGERS

In a two ball when circumstances arise and a group of three play instead of a group of four, one of the players becomes a “swinger”. No additional competition fee is charged but the “swinger” must nominate the player he wishes to partner in the competition. Should the “swinger” win the competition with his non designated partner, the “swinger” is **NOT** eligible for the winning prize.

TROPHIES

Two players having won any prize in a gross or net event on any day, including mixed events, are not eligible to win as partners for a period of 4 weeks.

EXCEPTIONS: this condition does not apply to the following major events - Club Foursomes Championship, Club Mixed Foursomes Championship, Mixed Canadian Foursomes, Gretna Green or Patrons Trophy.

HANDICAP REDUCTIONS

Ladies must check their golf link handicap before each round of competition play. This is the handicap you must then use.

SPECIAL NOTES RE COMPETITIONS

The Starter is in charge of the field and Ladies are requested to contact the Pro Shop when cancelling on day of play. If NOT booked in, the Starter may slot player into a vacant spot, providing there are No pre booked Ladies available. At other times the main office will attend to cancellations or include Ladies name on the time sheet. For 2 Ball and team events your Match Committee will attend to queries.

On Medal Days and Club Championships players who have not been drawn in their respective divisions, must play at the end of their divisions, not slot into vacant spots. Please register at the Pro Shop at least 20min prior to your tee time in case of cancellations.

Competitions are played over 18 holes unless otherwise stated. Cards must be signed by marker and counter signed by player and returned to competition box within 30 minutes of the completion of the round.

For non club events, players must book in at Pro Shop for tee time.
